B.C. CREDIT UNION DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARDS

PURPOSE:

The B.C. Distinguished Service Award is awarded to an individual in recognition of outstanding service in the B.C. credit union system. The award is not limited to credit union directors and employees, but includes all persons who have made excellent contributions to the BC credit union system, and the co-operative movement.

CRITERIA:

The criteria for awards may include service at the regional, provincial, national or international levels. The award recipient should have extensive background and practical experience in the development and operation of credit unions, demonstrated leadership in the preservation and extension of the philosophy of “people helping people”, awareness of the role of credit unions as co-operatively developed socio-economic institutions and the ability and willingness to speak forthrightly on credit union challenges and opportunities.

PROCESS:

Nomination papers are accepted to February 28th of the year of the awards ceremony.

The award recipients will be selected by the Board of Governance and Nominating Committee of CUFBC along with one representative from Central 1's Board of Directors.

A maximum of three awards will be given at each Awards Ceremony which will be held every other year in conjunction with the Central 1 AGM in Vancouver, B.C.

Notice in advance of the ceremony will be provided to the nominee, the nominator and to Central 1 Credit Union so that arrangements can be made for the nominee's attendance.

The recipients' names will be engraved on to the B.C. Distinguished Service Award Recipients Plaque which is on display at the Central 1 Credit Union Building lobby in Vancouver.
